Notes for Packet Pick-Up: It is highly recommended that participants attend packet pick-up on Friday, October 18th from 3:00pm to 7:00pm; however, packet pick-up will be available on the morning of the ride for individuals who cannot pick-up in advance. Ride day packet pick-up will open at 6:00am, but it is discouraged.

We advise ALL RIDERS to arrive with a full water bottle on ride morning. Water supply is limited on site before the ride starts. Please arrive prepared.

BIB and PACKET PICK-UP

All riders must show ID. If someone else is picking up your packet, they MUST have a photo or copy of your ID, no exceptions. Your Rider Packet contains a jersey bib number which should be pinned to the back of your jersey and a corresponding number bike tag to go on your seat post.

Rider Bib Number: Don't lose this number! All riders must wear a bib number for access to the start, aid stations, finish and bike parking.

You'll receive your t-shirt, Bike Legal drawstring bag with sponsor goodies, RideSB100 water bottle, and RideSB100 Musette Bag (100 Mile Only). The Gerard's Paella and AleSmith beer garden wristband (21+) will be given after you complete the ride at Gear Check.

PARKING

There is no free parking. Parking is available in the Chase Palm Park lot or nearby Harbor/surrounding lots for Packet pick up and for the ride Saturday.

Other Suggestions

<u>Garden Street Lot</u>, paid parking. First come, first serve.

3-hour and full-day paid parking is available at Leadbetter West and East Lots.

Santa Barbara City College Lots in Lots 2-C, 3, 5-2, 5-3, and 5-4 and permits may be purchased through the parking permit dispensers located in these lots. SEE MAP HERE

There are numerous lots around Santa Barbara City College. We suggest parking in one of those lots and then riding their bike to the start line less than 1 mile away.

Please obey all street and parking laws. Ride Santa Barbara is not responsible for any parking tickets or violations. Please check the meter or kiosks for the respective parking lot guidelines.

BAG & BIKE CHECK

Bag and bike check will be located at the start/finish line. Bag Check will be open from 6:00am to 8:00am. 100 Mile nutrition bag drop off will be open between 6:00am and 6:30am. The secure bike parking area will be open until 6:00pm and will be staffed by volunteers. You must show your bib number to retrieve checked bags and exit the bike parking area with your bike.

EXPO and FESTIVAL

The post-ride expo and festival will run from 11:00am-6:00pm at Chase Palm Park and

All RideSB100 merchandise orders can be picked up at the Expo on Friday and Saturday. If you didn't pre-order, we will have limited inventory available for purchase on site!

BEER GARDEN

Your wristband is your ticket for 1 meal and 2 beverages. Present your ID to get your wristband at packet pick up. Friends and family are welcome to join the festival and can purchase a wristband for meals and drinks (over 21 only). Visit the Solutions booth for details.

BIKE RENTALS WITH UNLIMITED BIKING

Don't have a bike for the event? No problem! Rent a Cannondale or Specialized bike with Unlimited Biking! All bikes will be brought to the start location and picked up at the end location for convenience. Helmets are provided with all rentals. Reserve your bike here. Thursday October 17th is the last day to rent.

AWARDS CEREMONY

Join us at 3:30pm for the <u>Gibraltar Climb</u> <u>Challenge</u> awards presentation! Riders must be present to win. The Gibraltar Climb
Challenge is your opportunity to compete for
the King or Queen of the Mountain jerseys
for 1st place overall / 1st place in each age
group for both men and women. First,
second, and third place winners will receive
Award Medals. You must be at the top of
Gibraltar by 12pm to be eligible.

Overall Awards will be presented for riders in the 100 Mile and 100KM + Climb. Age Group Awards will be presented for riders in the 100 Mile and 100KM + Climb events only.

COURSE INFORMATION

All courses will start and finish at Chase Palm Park. You can view complete maps with elevation profiles for each course at ridesb100.com/details/.

All courses are open to traffic. Please obey all traffic laws, which includes stopping at stop signs and lights.

Look for Ride Santa Barbara branded signage throughout the ride, along with colored arrows on the road that correspond to your course turns:

Yellow – 100 Mile Green – 100KM + CLIMB Blue – 100KM Coastal Red – 34 Mile

We recommend that you download your route using Strava with your bike-mounted computer or phone.

COURSE RULES

- 1. Helmets must be worn throughout the ride, NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 2. All riders must obey all traffic laws, which includes stopping at stop signs and lights.
- 3. Bike trailers and time trial bars (aero bars) are prohibited.
- 4. Refrain from wearing earbuds or earphones in both ears, to ensure that you are able to stay aware of approaching/oncoming traffic.
- 5. Please do not litter on course.
- 6. All riders must have their bibs visible at all times*. Riders without a bib/bike/helmet tag will be asked to exit the course and will not be allowed to access aid stations and/or the start/finish line festival area.

*Registration includes rider accident medical liability insurance. Unregistered riders pose a risk to all attendees.

If you need mechanical, SAG, or medical support, or need to report a "did not finish," please call the number above and select the option that pertains to your needs.

HAZARDS

Many roads on the courses are steep, have blind or sharp corners, debris or gravel, and uneven road surfaces. Please ride with caution. Each cyclist is responsible for being aware of cars pulling out of driveways, pedestrians, other cyclists, and oncoming traffic. Please watch your speed on all descents and watch for oncoming traffic. **Do not cross over the center line**.

Riders on the 100-mile and 100k + Climb routes are urged to use extreme caution on the dangerous descents of Painted Cave Road and Old San Marcos Road.

RESPECT OUR NEIGHBORS

The Painted Cave descent includes residents whose only access to their neighborhood is up or down this road. We ask that riders ride single file in this section and beware of oncoming traffic at corners. BE POLITE AND DO NOT EXCEED 20MPH DOWNHILL SPEED on Painted Cave Road prior to Hwy 154.

TIMING

Although this is not a race, you will receive timing materials at packet pick-up. Please wear your bib at all times and attach the numbered bike tag to your bike. Results will be posted on our website. There will be no award rankings other than the Climb Challenge results.

WEATHER

Ride Santa Barbara 100 will take place rain or shine. We encourage riders to check the forecast and prepare accordingly.

SAG

SAG (support crews) will be on the course to assist you on your ride. If necessary, move safely to the side of the road and call us at **844-320-0728** if you don't see a support person. We will dispatch support to you via our SAG crew and radio operators.

In an emergency, call 911.

ON COURSE MECHANICS

Velofix will be the official on-course bike mechanic. Need a quick tune-up or a fix during your ride? Call **844-320-0728**, and their team will be ready to help, so you can focus on enjoying your ride along the American Riviera.

SPECTATORS

Friends and family are welcome! Spectators are welcome to the Expo to enjoy demos by our sponsors and booths as well! Food and drink wristbands will be available for purchase at the solutions table.

AID STATIONS

There will be 5 <u>aid stations</u> along the main routes. Aid stations are stocked with fresh water, electrolyte drinks, Energy gels, fruit, bars, soda, comfort foods, and snacks.

Light Support stations will offer water, bars, gels, and electrolyte support.

Full Support stations will offer more substantial nutrition, such as burritos, in addition to water, bars, gels, and electrolyte support.

There will be minimal bike supplies at our aid stations. Please make sure your bike is in

good working order and we suggest bringing your own bike repair kit as backup.

100-MILE NUTRITION BAGS

For riders participating in the 100-mile ride, you will have the option to fill your Ride SB100 musette bag (available at packet pick up) or personal bag with your own nutrition supplies and send it on course for pick up at the top of Gibraltar Hill (Aid Station 3).

Nutrition bags need to be dropped at the bag check **area by 6:30am** on Saturday morning and must be clearly labeled with your bib number (we recommend using duct tape and Sharpie).

After riders have used the items in their nutrition bag, empty musettes can be handed back off at Aid Station 4.
